## Conditions For Alliance Technical Group's LAP Renewal

1) The South Coast AQMD shall be notified at least seven days prior to scheduled test dates for all source tests performed in the South Coast District which require LAP testing. This notification is necessary in order to conduct site audits of LAP firms. Notifications shall be transmitted to Colin Eckerle by e-mail at ceckerle@aqmd.gov, and shall include the name of the facility, the address, proposed test methods, and the name, phone number and e-mail address of the facility contact. This notification requirement may be waived, once a successful audit is completed for the test method.
